# Portfolio option

# Portfolio option

- o Following guiding parameters
  - o Core Learning
  - o Competencies
  - o Descriptive feedback
  - o Student voice
  - o Authentic Evidence
  - o Next Steps



# Portfolio option

- o Three type of posts: snapshots, celebrations, and summaries
- o Minimum number is determined by district [here](#)
  - o 5 literacy
  - o 3 numeracy
  - o 2 each of science, social studies, PE, arts
  - o 2 summary of learning
  - o Celebrations are optional

# MyEducationBC Option

- o What grades do I enter?
  - o Grade scale 1-3 for kindergarten
  - o Grade scale 1-4 for primary and intermediate
  - o No letter grades until term 3



# MyEducationBC Option

- o How do I enter comments?
  - o Current and new curriculum are in WORD format to copy and paste
  - o There is no limit to comment length





# MyEducationBC Option

- o Some great features...
  - o You or the office can print reports after teacher posts grades
  - o Teachers can easily share classes
