Nearly 44 million views! Over 23 000 comments!

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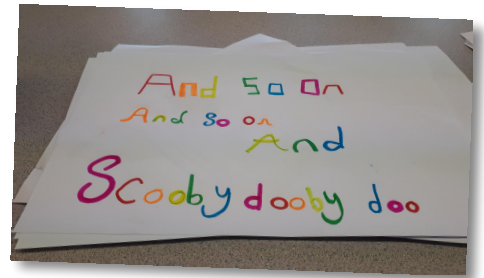


Create Something: Let's create our own video to the song *Everyday People* by Sly and the Family Stone (2:23).
