



How to Access the Research Databases (*ERAC BC Digital Classroom)

There are a few ways to access the Research Databases. Note that if you are at home, you will need to login to enter them. The logins can be found on your school's library home page, once you have logged into your school library:




Method #1 - At School:

Click on the **Google Chrome Browser** icon on the school's laptop. This will take you directly to your "My Site" page:




Click on the button for **ERAC BC Digital Classroom** and the list of Resource Databases will appear with active links:




Method #2 - School District Home Page Resources Button:

Click on **Resources**:




Then click on **Research Databases**:


