

Creating an iMovie of an Audio Recording

Create an audio recording with a picture that can go into ePortfolios

Introduction

When putting audio recordings into ePortfolios, you currently get a black box on the screen while you listen and it looks like there should be a video. To fix this problem, you can record the audio using iMovie and put a picture of the book or reading selection up in place of the black screen. (Thank you Noah Burdett for the idea!)



Creating the Audio Recording


1 First you must open **iMovie** on your iPad or iPhone.

2 Click **Projects** at the top.
Click on the **+** to start a new project




3 Choose to Make an **iMovie** (not a Trailer).

4 Click on **Create Movie** at the bottom of the screen.



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Click on the Camera icon.



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Make sure that your camera is on **Photo** by sliding the word video up.

Take a picture of the reading selection or book that the child is reading.

Click on **Use Photo**.




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Click on the microphone icon (it is beside the camera).

Press record and have the child read their selection.

When you are done, press **Accept**.




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


Click on the picture in the timeline to select it (it will turn yellow on the edges) then use your finger to drag it to the right to extend it until it is the same length as the audio recording

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After the audio recording is made it will show up below the image as new "track".

Touch it to get the option of a volume icon. Select the volume Icon and you can adjust the volume increasing it to 500% of the original. This really helps with those quiet readers.



10	Click on Done in the top left corner.	
11	<p>Click on the square with the up arrow at the bottom of the screen and then click on Save Video.</p> <p>When you are saving, choose medium – 360p.</p>	
Adding the Recording to an ePortfolio		
1	Open up the student's eportfolio.	
2	Click on the Video icon add a video.	
3	Add a title and then click on Add Video .	
4	Click on Photo Library.	
5	Click on Use in the top right corner.	
6	You can write a description below the video if you wish. If not, click Submit and you are done.
