How to create QR codes and save voice recordings in My Site:

- 1. Open your email and find the email from the student or ipad with the voice recording. Right click on the recording file in your email and click **Save As**...
- 2. Save the recording on your computer, in a folder that you create for that class. I have been naming the recordings by the name of the book. Don't put any spaces in the file name ex. TheKissThatMissed.mp3
- 3. Log in to "My Site" and find the "QR Code Recordings" page

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- 4. Look at the navigation bar at the top and find the school and class that the student is from and click on it
- 5. Click on +Add Media



6. Click **Choose File** and find the recording on your computer where you saved it. Then click on **ok.** When the next screen comes up scroll to the bottom and click **Save**.

Now you need to create a QR Code:

1. Open the voice recording file from **My Site** by clicking on it

2. Copy the URL (web address) from the top



- 3. Open a QR Code Generator-www.qrstuff.com works fine
- 4. Paste the URL of the voice recording in the spot for the Website address. It will generate a new code for us on the right side of the screen
- 5. Click to download the QR code and save it to your computer (save it by the name of the book again with no spaces)



- 6. Open the code and copy it, then paste it on the page where the codes are saved. I use Green shot:
 - a. Click on 📓 at the bottom of your screen
 - b. Click and drag to create a square around your QR Code
 - c. Click on Copy to Clipboard
 - d. Press Ctrl + V or right click and click Paste to paste it into your desired destination For example:
