


Talk Typer

Introduction

Talk Typer is a free Speech to Text website available only in Google Chrome. Once speech is translated to text, it can then be copied and pasted into any word processor, text box or online text based environment.

Integration Ideas

- Use Speech to Text for completing assignments, blogs, form completion any written out put task
- Use SpeakIt! extension Text to Speech to hear the text read back to you to review your writing.
