- Reader View (Text Processing)
- Large Text (Text Processing)
- Display Accommodations (Text Processing)
- Read&Write on the Keyboard and in Safari (Word Prediction and Text to Speech)
- Keedogo keyboard Open Dyslexic font, larger font/ high contrast keyboard with Word Prediction
- Use AAC Talker apps (Touch Chat, LAMP) and copy paste from message window
- Guided access (lock into an app/ can set timer)
- Camera app on iPhone will read Text
- Switch access, vision access, eye gaze access
