### TWERL Phonics Go! Decode Set 1


"TwERL Phonics has been developed specifically for emerging tween readers who are developing their decoding skills. Written at emergent and beginning reader levels, the books have been carefully controlled to showcase phonics skills, beginning with CVC words and progressing through long vowels, -controlled vowels, digraphs, and multisyllabic words."

Each of the 3 levels features eight 16-page books, six fiction and two non-fiction. There are three copies of each title and an accompanying teacher guide. (Reading level: 0.5 to 0.9)

Tween Emergent Reader Libraries: Go! Emerge



This new series features topics and genres particularly of interest to upper elementary and middle school students but written at a 0.5 reading level. The set includes three copies of each of the 20 titles (fiction and non-fiction) plus a teacher guide, and fills the challenging area of providing high interest ageappropriate titles for struggling intermediate readers. (48-pages each, written at true emergent levels with full-color photographs on every page to support comprehension.)









create a landscape for each season or for two to three students to create a landscape for the same season.








## **Storytelling: Penguin's Big Adventure**


Life size model of the male urinary system.



#### Makerspaces: Remaking Your Play and STEAM Learning Areas


