

## BELT & SPINDLE SANDER

The purpose of a belt or spindle sander is to **SMOOTH A STRAIGHT OR CURVED CUT** 

- 1) Always use appropriate eye protection.
- 2) Don't use the abrasive belt/spindle if it is torn or damaged. Report it to the instructor if it is damaged.
- 3) The material **MUST** be held flat against the table and hands kept clear of the abrasive belt/spindle.



- 4) **ALL** adjustments to the machine are made **BEFORE** starting it.
- 5) Always check to make sure the table is adjusted for the angle that you want. Use a square to do this.
- 6) Sand against the direction the spindle/belt is spinning.
- 7) Do not leave the machine until it has come to a full stop.
- 8) Do not use metal on the belt sander or spindle sander. Sparks can get into the dust extraction and start a fire.
- 9) One operator only at a time.
