

## **Bandsaw Jewelry Box**

- Decide what your jewelry box will look like, then get the pieces of wood from the teacher (Top and Bottom) that are cut to the size you want.
- 2. Design your layout in Inkscape
  - Set the page size to match the piece of wood you have under Document Properties"
  - Draw your shape, bring in images.
  - Have the teacher check it **BEFORE** you print it!
- 3. Print your design out on the "Tech-P" printer in the Metal/Jewelry Shop.
- 4. Print the design to the Laser Engraver Software
  - Setting will be 90% Power, 75% Speed
  - Take your laptop and piece of wood to the Laser
    Engraver and engrave the top







5. Cut out the paper and using a glue stick from the teacher, glue it to the bottom piece of wood. You should now have what is below.



- 6. Using the bandsaw, cut the outside shape
  - Make sure your hands are <u>NEVER</u> if front of the blade!!
- Once the outside shape is cut out, using your finger and a pencil, draw a 10-15mm offset line to the inside as shown
- 8. Now, using the Band Saw, cut the inside out. You may have to stop the bandsaw and remove pieces.

- Glue the piece back together and clamp it.
- 10. Using the spindle sander, clean up the inside of the box.
- 11. Carefully use the belt sander to sand edges smooth, or use sandpaper and a sanding block to sand areas that cannot be reached with a sander.

















- 12. Have the teacher help you with routing out the bottom13. Cut a thin piece of plywood to fit in the bottom.
- 14. Cut the top piece on the bandsaw, then clean up to match the bottom piece.
