LEARNING OUTCOME: In this activity participants will learn how to use the **Readability** Extension in Google Chrome.

ABOUT: **Readability** removes visual clutter from web pages and articles making them easier to read.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED: A computer with Google Chrome Browser and an internet connection with the Readability Extension installed (If the Readability extensions is not installed click [HERE](#).) You will know **Readability** is added because you will see a **Red Couch** in the upper right hand menu bar. (SD71 computers have Readability installed already)






<p>1 In Chrome open any text article that you want to read such e.g. France in Simple English Wikipedia.</p> 	<p>2 Click on the Readability Extension (Red Couch) in the top right hand corner. Click Read Now.</p> 
<p>3 The webpage will then open in a decluttered format.</p> 	<p>4 On the left hand side tools are available to personalize the appearance of the webpage.</p>
