1. Using Google Chrome,

- 2. Find and click on Use it online (blue text on the right side)
- 3. Click on + Story
- 4. Give your story a title and click on +Add

6. Next, type your title twice where it reads *Double-click this passage to edit it.*

The **blue highlighted text** links to the next card and is the story pathway the viewer will click.

## Adding an image to a card:

First you need to find an image that is acceptable to use (copyright free).

- 1. Type the image topic into your Google Chrome browser.
- 2. Click on Images
- 3. Click on Tools
- 4. Click on Usage Rights
- 5. Click on Labeled for noncommercial reuse
- 6. Find your image
- 7. Click on it
- 8. Click on View Image
- 9. Copy the URL at the top (the address for the photograph)



Carefully type the following line of code in your story where you would like the photograph to appear:
