



ACTIVITY/TASK: iPad Speak Selection (Voices in English and French (Canada))

LEARNING OUTCOME: Participants will learn how to turn on Speak Selection in Settings on the iPad. This easy to use accessibility feature will be used to read text aloud on the internet.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED: An open web page.



HOW TO: In this activity you will use the program to read a PDF in iBooks and selected text from the internet.

<p>1</p>	<p>Tap on the Settings app, locate General settings. Tap Accessibility, locate the Vision area. Tap Speak Selection. Toggle it to ON. Choose a Voice. Turn the Speaking Rate down by moving the slider to the left. Tap the Home button to close.</p> 	<p>2</p> <p>Open any webpage. Mars surface color</p> 
<p>3</p>	<p>With the webpage open place your finger on one word and then lift it.</p> 	<p>4</p> <p>Drag the blue balls to select the text to be read.</p>

Tap Speak to hear the text read aloud. Once you tap Speak the option changes from Speak to Pause. Tap Pause to pause the text.

Tap Define to obtain a definition of a word that you don't know.
