Facts from article

1. Considered leaving their jobs (sample is 1002 adults)
 - 33% of Women surveyed
 - 19% of men surveyed
2. 1/6 of all jobs held by women disappeared in Feb/Mar – Stats Can
3. Re-employment in Ontario was 158,400 for men / 95,500 for women
4. Reasons for impact on women
 - School shut downs
 - Child care
 - Business shutdowns of sectors that employ mostly women (food services, hospitality, retail, educational services and social assistance)
