### PM Family Levelled Readers

**Title: Flyleaf Emergent Readers Book Set:**

**Decodable Book Kits by Primary Phonics Storybooks – Mac and Tab**

Heart words are essential to create a story. 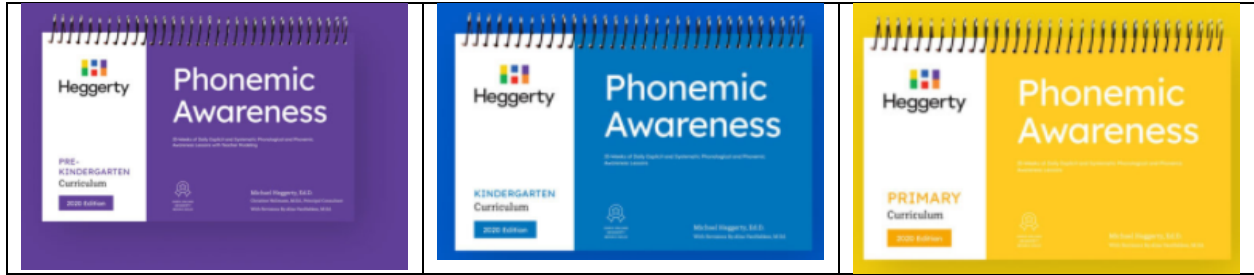

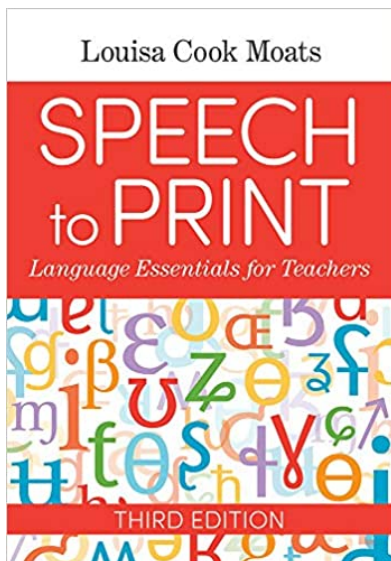

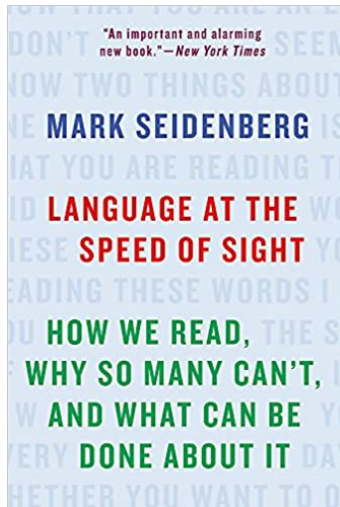


### ***Speech to Print: Language Essentials for Teachers*** by Louisa Cook Moats

### ***Language at the Speed of Sight: How We Read, Why So Many Can't, and What Can Be Done About It***, by Mark Seidenberg

And while we press children to develop large vocabularies because we think being a good reader means knowing more words, studies have found that a large vocabulary is only an indication of better pattern recognition.
