



How to Play Spot It

Version 1: The Tower

1. Each student starts with one card in front of them.
2. The other cards go face-up in a pile in the center (the Tower!)
3. When the game begins, students look for a symbol that is on both their own card and the one in the center. When they find it, they have to say the name of the symbol in French.
4. The first person to say the name of a matching symbol takes the card from the top of the Tower and places it on top of their own card. They now use that card to find the common object between their card and the newly revealed Tower card.
5. The game continues! When there are no more cards in the Tower, the students count the cards in their own piles. The student with the most cards wins.

Version 2: The Well

1. The cards are divided equally among the students, with one card in the center to start the Well.
2. When the game begins, students look for a symbol that is on both their own card and the one in the center. When they find it, they have to say the name of the symbol in French.
3. The first person to say the name of a matching symbol takes the card from the top of their pile, and puts it in the Well. Everyone now uses the top card of the Well to find the next match.
4. The game continues! The first student to put all their cards in the Well wins.
