Confused about the different levelling systems of professionally levelled readers? If so, you are not alone!

Over the last two years the LRC has greatly expanded both the Decodable Book collection and the Levelled Reader collection, in collaboration with Heather Willms. Publishers of Levelled Readers, however, often use different levelling systems which makes it challenging to compare levels from one publisher to another. To assist you with borrowing LRC Levelled Readers that use differing levelling systems, I have posted two levelling conversion charts to the [LRC - Reading Section of Learn71](#).
