





SD71 ACCESSIBILITY TECH TIP

Using Immersive Reader in Word Online Office 365 with ARCBC or e-text on PC, MAC, and iPad

ABOUT: In this activity, participants will learn how to use Immersive Reader in Word and OneNote Online in Office 365 with ARCBC file or any document. Immersive Reader has Text to Speech, reading comprehension options and options for processing and visual impairments.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED: To be online in a browser. A downloaded .docx file from ARCBC or text file open in Word Online in Office 365. You user name and login for Office 365.



<p>1 Open Office 365 and Word Online. Open a .docx text document (from ARCBC or elsewhere). https://www.comoxvalleyschools.ca/</p> 	<p>2 Click on Edit in Browser to open the document. Click on the View tab and Immersive Reader. The document will open in the Immersive Reader viewer.</p> 
<p>3 With the Immersive Reader Grammar Options, you can select syllables and parts of speech. With the Reading Preferences, you can pick line focus, turn picture dictionary on (click on a word to use) or translate.</p> 	<p>4 With the Immersive Reader Text Preferences 'A' tool you can change</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Text Size• Line Spacing• Fonts• Themes <p>To change Voice Settings click speaker icon. Click the read arrow to have text read aloud.</p>
