Core Word Focus: GET

Core words are the powerful, flexible words we use every day for most of our communication. A core word approach gives the AAC learner focused practice with these important words that will help them communicate effectively in many different situations for many different reasons.

The word **get** is one of those powerful, flexible words we take for granted (e.g., **get**, give, can, use, put, have, do, make) and therefore may not think to model on the communication devices. **Get** has a few meanings:

- to become (get dressed, get bigger, get ready)
- to attain something (get candy, get a prize)
- to retrieve something out of sight or reach (get your coat, get me that book)
- to mean *understand* (I *get* it; she *gets* me). It allows the person to request things, direct others' actions, and interact about an idea.

Examples:

Let's **get** going! I **get** it! I'm gonna **get** you! Time to **get** dressed. I **got** it! What have you **got**?

I want to get ice cream! **Get** ready! Go **get** it!

Get outta here! **Get** lost. We are **getting** juice.

Get up—it's breakfast time. Let's get a book. I get to have hot chocolate

On your mark, **get** set, go! You've **got** this! **Get** better!
