Core Word Focus: GET

Core words are the powerful, flexible words we use every day for most of our communication. A core word approach gives the AAC learner focused practice with these important words that will help them communicate effectively in many different situations for many different reasons.

The word **get** is one of those powerful, flexible words we take for granted (e.g., **get**, give, can, use, put, have, do, make) and therefore may not think to model on the communication devices. **Get** has a few meanings:

- to become (**get** dressed, **get** bigger, **get** ready)
- to attain something (**get** candy, **get** a prize)
- to retrieve something out of sight or reach (**get** your coat, **get** me that book)
- to mean understand (I **get** it; she **gets** me). It allows the person to request things, direct others' actions, and interact about an idea.

Examples:

Let's get going!	I get it!	I'm gonna get you!
Time to get dressed.	I got it!	What have you got ?
I want to get ice cream!	Get ready!	Go get it!
Get outta here!	Get lost.	We are getting juice.
Get up—it's breakfast time.	Let's get a book.	I get to have hot chocolate
On your mark, get set, go!	You've got this!	Get better!




