ABOUT:

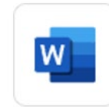
In this activity, participants will learn how to use Immersive Reader in Word Online in Office 365 with an ARCBC file or any document. Immersive Reader has Text to Speech, reading comprehension options and options for processing and visual impairments.


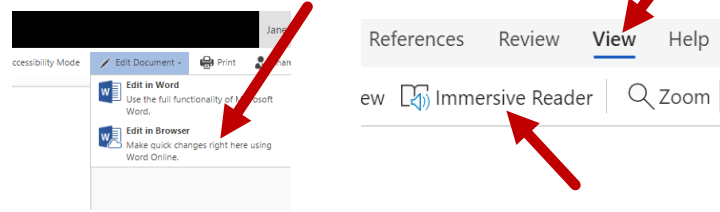
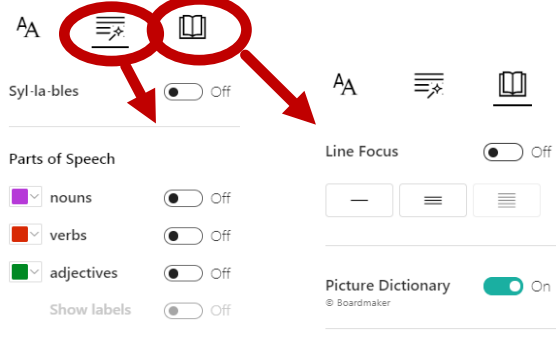
WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

To be online in a browser. A downloaded .docx file from ARCBC or text file open in Word Online in Office 365. Username and login for Office 365.

<p>1 Open Office 365 and Word Online. Open a .docx text document (from ARCBC or web). https://www.comoxvalleyschools.ca/</p> 	<p>2 Click on Edit in Browser to open the document online. Click on the View tab and Immersive Reader. The document will open in the Immersive Reader viewer.</p> 
<p>3 Immersive Reader Grammar Options, select syllables and parts of speech. Reading Preferences, pick line focus, turn picture dictionary on (click word to use) or translate.</p> 	<p>4 Immersive Reader Text Preferences 'A' tool</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Text Size • Line Spacing • Fonts • Themes <p>To change Voice Settings, click speaker icon.
