




SD71 Predictive (Word Prediction) iOS 17 (iPad)

Introduction: Predictive (Word Prediction) is a tool that is built into the Apple iOS, using the Apple keyboard. Predictive provides word suggestions based on the letters that have been entered. There are multiple third party keyboards that also provide word prediction but this tutorial will be restricted to the built in Apple keyboard.

Learning Objectives:

Completion of this tutorial will give you experience with the following:

- Set up word prediction on an iDevice.
- Use word prediction when typing.
- Turn on hold to speak predictions to hear words read out loud.

Open an app that supports typing using the Apple keyboard (e.g. Notes). Type a sentence. Note that as letters are entered (1), a selection of words will appear above the keyboard. To enter a word that is predicted, simply tap on the word (2) which will then appear in the main body of text.



Predicted words read out loud

To have the predicted words read out loud you can turn on Hold to Speak

Predictions in the Accessibility Settings.

Open the Settings app by tapping the Settings icon. Select Accessibility on the left-hand side. Select Spoken Content on the right-hand side



Under Spoken Content, Select Typing Feedback. Turn on Hold to Speak Predictions (green).

When back in the app on the apple keyboard to hear the predicted words read out loud, tap and hold finger on the word to hear it spoken.
