

AI "DETECTION"

AI detectors have proven *not* to be dependable therefore they should *not* be used to determine if a student has "cheated". They have a frequency of *false positives*, are very discriminative and often don't "catch" the AI tech savy student.

Some signs to look for to detect AI generated work.



The submission is too long. Assignment asks for a certain length but student submits something longer.



Assignment is too long yet still is missing key components -> citations, cover page, personal connection.



Writing is emotionless even when describing personal reflections or memories.



Uses excessive lists and bullet points instead of paragraphs. AI generators often present info in this way



It's mistake free. It's just TOO perfect.



Writing doesn't match student's other work.

Trust your gut. If something is just "off", explore more. Start with a conversation rather than a confrontation.
