



# MICROSOFT TEAMS CLASSROOM NORMS



## Use Clear Communication

Use language understood by all. Avoid using lingo (slang) or unclear language that could lead to misunderstandings.



## Be Respectful

Respect the opinions of your classmates. Do not bully or verbally abuse those you disagree with. Remember that others are allowed to have opinions of their own.



## Respect Others' Time

Avoid sending unnecessary messages or notifications that could distract others. Inappropriate or annoying posts will result in you being muted.



## Mind Your Tone

Be mindful of your language and use appropriate emojis to communicate emotions if necessary.



## Be Responsive



If someone @mentions you in a chat or channel, try to respond in a timely manner, even if it's just to acknowledge the message with a thumbs up or smiley emoji.

## No All Caps



Typing in all capital letters is considered shouting online. Use capitalization sparingly for emphasis only. If wanting to emphasize something, use italics instead.

## @Mentions Use



Use @mentions *only* to get someone's attention. Do not use @teammgroup. This is reserved for the teacher only.

## GIFs and Emojis



While occasional emojis and GIFs can add some personality to your messages, using them excessively *and* inappropriately are not acceptable.
