A vision board is like a big poster where you put pictures, words, and symbols that show your goals and dreams. It's a way to see what you want to achieve in your life.

For this vision board, you'll focus on the phrase "I am digitally literate".

You can include things you're already doing and things you want to learn or get better at.

Review and Identify Items Your Vision Board

- Highlight information from the previous lesson to include.
- Identify additional items that represent you as a digitally literate citizen.



Add Engaging Text

- Use short, engaging text with different fonts and effects.
- Add inspiring quotes related to digital literacy.



Choose a Template

 Review the templates available from the discussion post in the Class Team.



Highlight Achievements

• Showcase your digital literacy milestones with icons or badges.





Use a Consistent Colour Scheme

 Choose and stick to a cohesive color scheme. Use the Design -> Styles in Canva for color palettes.





Elaborate with Canva Elements

• Enhance your vision board with graphics, icons, and frames





Add Images to Support Your Statement


 Add images that demonstrate your digital literacy. You can upload images of yourself if you like.





Keep it Simple

 Avoid clutter. Use readable fonts and complementary colors. Add elements that enhance but do not overwhelm the vision board.



Create Clear Sections

• Divide your vision board into different sections based on the headings developed in the previous lesson.

They don't need to be labeled, just organized this way.

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Feedback and Submission

• Share your design for feedback and make improvements. Share the link to the discussion board to submit your final copy.
