



THE “NEW LEARNER EXPERIENCE” VIEW

In the **New Learner Experience**, the table of contents allows students to explore all available content (modules, topics, and activities) within the course. Every time the student accesses the Content, a **Continue tile** is displayed, allowing the students to quickly resume from where they left off. Students can use the **expansion arrows** to view items within the Unit Folders as well as see number of items **Completed** right from the module.

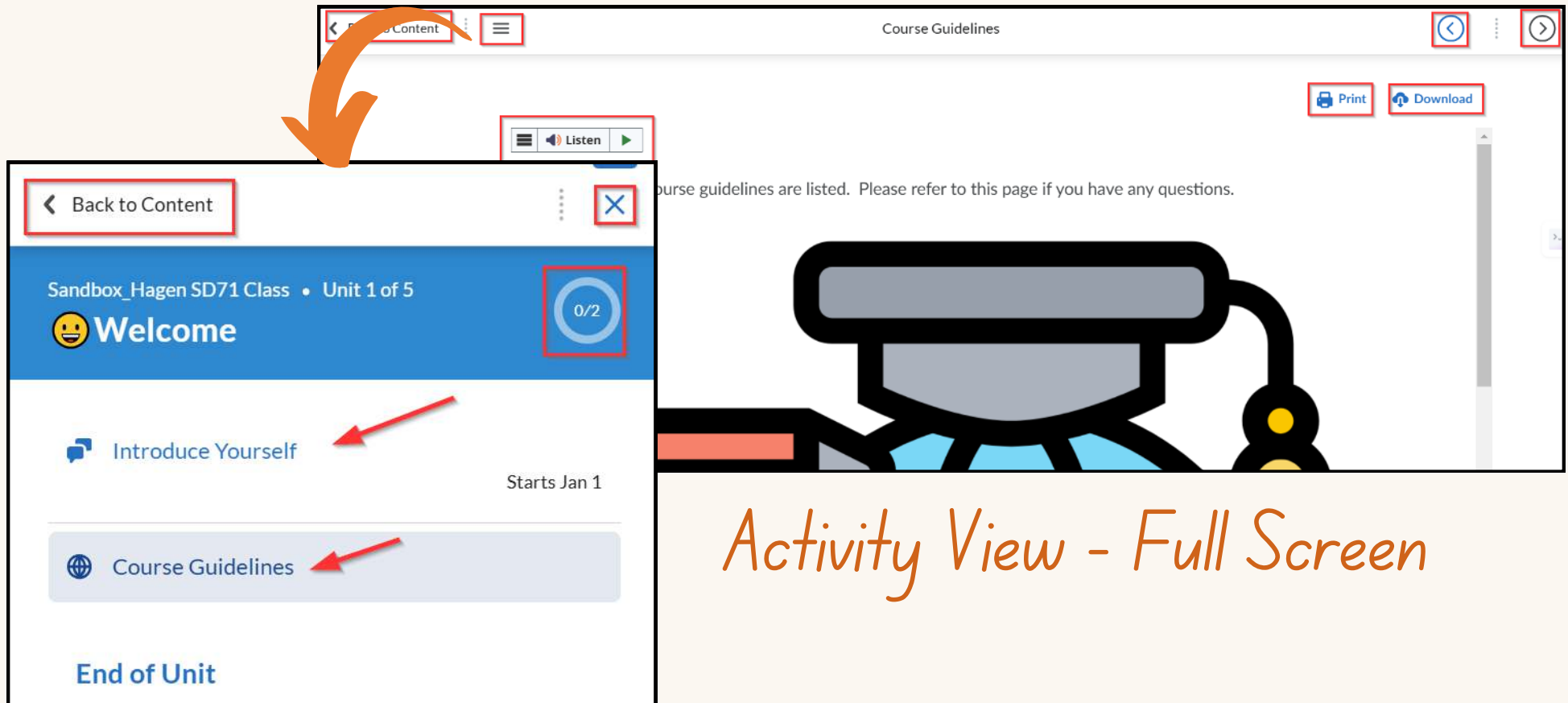

THE “NEW LEARNER EXPERIENCE” VIEW

Opening a specific activity opens it as a full screen. It allows users to navigate to other activities using the **Navigation Arrows** on the top right. Students can also **print** or **download** the content within the activity.

Clicking on the **Hamburger menu** opens a navigation sidebar within the activity screen. It provides the student with the opportunity to navigate to other lessons quickly.
