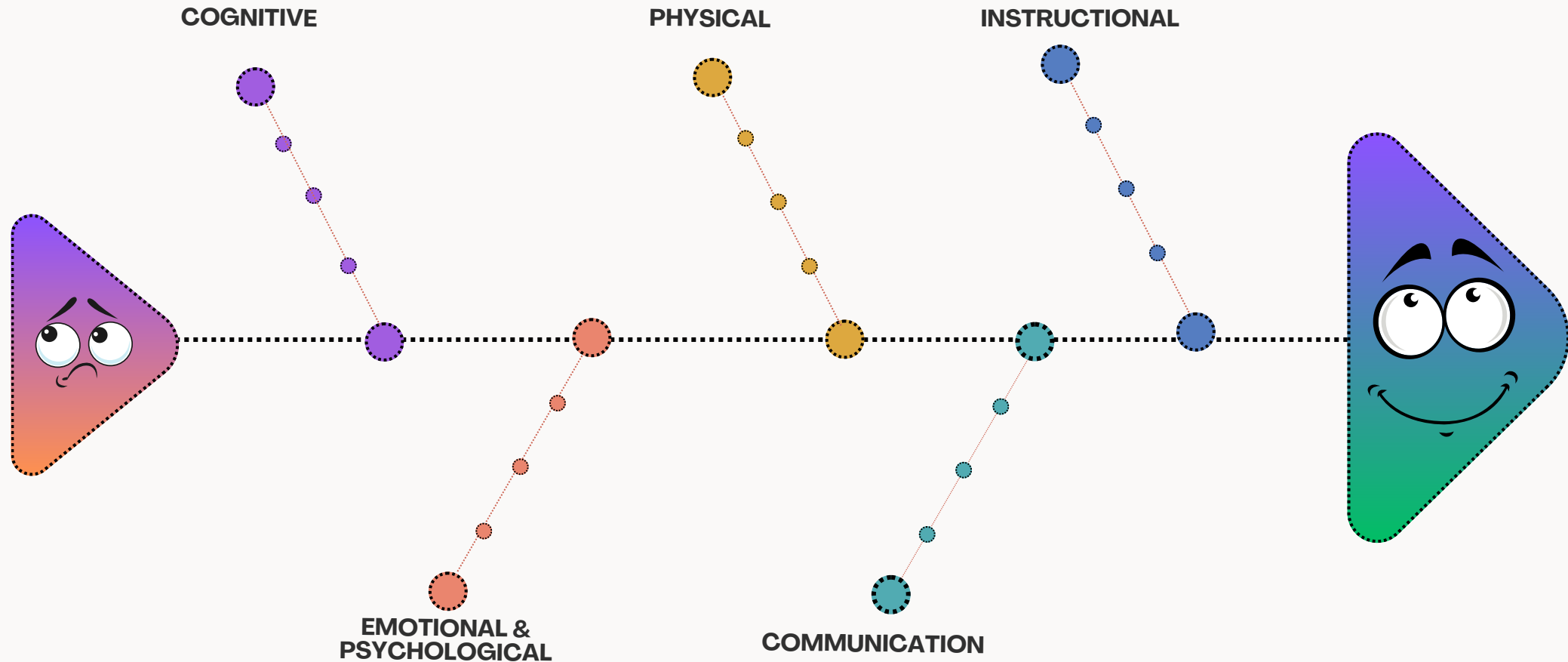


Remove the Barrier: Fishbone Diagram



On the left of the fish's “rib bones”, identify specific barriers under each heading students may encounter in their learning environment which may prevent them from being successful learners. THEN looking at the UDL examples, on the right, list some UDL “activities” that will address these barriers.
NOTE: No need to be specific in the type of activities. This will be addressed later.
