

Adrienne Gear Reading Strategy Kits for Intermediate Students:

These 5 kits contain picture books in English, as well as some in French, targeted towards Intermediate students and the explicit teaching of Reading Power strategies. There are plenty of titles to choose from to meet the interests and needs of your students. I find the strategies very helpful in explaining to others why I like a certain book: "When I read the part about the students trying to herd the goats I could see it and it made me chuckle", "I could relate to the boy's disappointment as it reminded me of how my son responded as a disappointed two-year-old" every time we kept driving past the Golden Arches", "I never understood what it would be like to...and now that I do it has transformed my thinking."



His friends, a seagull, a raccoon, a squirrel, and a pelican work with him as the Assistant eyes, observing the humans and other animals who share the park and making sure the Equilibrium is in balance. But changes are afoot. More humans arrive in the park. A new building, containing mysterious and hypnotic rectangles, goes up. And then there are the goats, an actual boatload of goats who appear, along with a shocking revelation that changes Johannes's view of the world. Lushly illustrated with old world paintings and new artwork from Caldecott honoree Shawn Harris, this story about friendship, beauty, liberation (and running very, very fast), will make readers of all ages see the world around them in a wholly new way.
