### INTERESTING TOPICS

**Early Learning Basics** is a fun way to teach foundational skills, such as letters, numbers, and more, to young children.

**High interest topics** such as Sea Creatures, People at Work, and Dinosaurs provide access to worlds of content to explore.

### CONTENT VARIETY

Students can access short **non-fiction videos**, digital games, fiction, and non-fiction small **books** and digital activities.

The educational **games and activities** reinforce early childhood building blocks and learning.

### READ-ALOUD BOOKS

When students click on the topics, they are taken to a page with **read-aloud books** (they can read the books or have the books read to them), videos, games, and activities.

The read-aloud options across all functions help to **promote comprehension**.

The **Grown Ups** section includes information about the featured content and **curricular connections**.

A provided **guided reading program** includes lesson plans and **printable books** for students.
