

Multiplication War!



How to Play


Learning Target:

Development of computational fluency and multiplicative thinking requires analysis of patterns and relations in multiplication and division.

Materials: Deck of cards

Instructions:

- Before beginning, you will want to pull all the jokers, jacks, queens, and kings from the deck.
- Shuffle the cards and deal the entire deck to both players. Each player should have an equal amount of cards.
- To start each player will turn over the top two cards in their stack and lay them side by side. Then, each player will multiply their two cards together.
- The player with the largest product gets all four cards. Put them in a discard pile. Each player will have their own discard pile.
- If both players have the same product, then lay out two sets of cards face down and flip the third set to try again. Winner with highest product takes all cards.
- Keep playing until the two piles of cards are gone.
- After all the cards have been played, each player will count the cards in their discard pile. The player with the most cards wins.



24 is a higher product than 14. Player 2 wins this round.
