How to Lock Screen Rotation on an iPad (9th Generation) – the one with the Home button

1. Hold your iPad in any orientation (portrait or landscape).
2. **Swipe down from the top-right corner** of the screen to open **Control Center**.
3. Look for the **Rotation Lock** icon: it looks like a lock with a circular arrow around it
4. Tap the icon once.



Red / highlighted = Rotation locked



Grey / dimmed = Rotation unlocked

5. Swipe up or tap the screen to close Control Center.

How to Lock Screen Rotation on an iPad (10th Generation) – No home button

1. Open Control Center
 - **Swipe down from the top-right corner** of the screen.
(Same motion as checking battery percentage.)
2. Tap the Rotation Lock Button
 - Look for the icon that shows a **lock with a circular arrow**:
 - Tap it once to **turn rotation lock ON**.

- When it is **ON**, the icon will be **highlighted**.



3. Close Control Center

- Swipe up or tap on the screen.

How to Unlock Rotation

- Repeat the steps above and tap the rotation lock icon again to turn it **OFF**.
