INTERESTING TOPICS

Early Learning Basics is a fun way to teach foundational skills, such as letters, numbers, and more, to young children.

High interest topics such as Sea Creatures, People at Work, and Dinosaurs provide access to worlds of content to explore.

CONTENT VARIETY

Students can access short **non-fiction videos**, digital games, fiction, and non-fiction small **books** and digital activities.

The educational **games and activities** reinforce early childhood building blocks and learning.

READ-ALOUD BOOKS

When students click on the topics, they are taken to a page with **read-aloud books** (they can read the books or have the books read to them), videos, games, and activities.

The read-aloud options across all functions help to **promote comprehension**.

The **Grown Ups** section includes information about the featured content and **curricular connections**.

A provided **guided reading program** includes lesson plans and **printable books** for students.
