1. Open the Bitsboard app (Free or Pro)



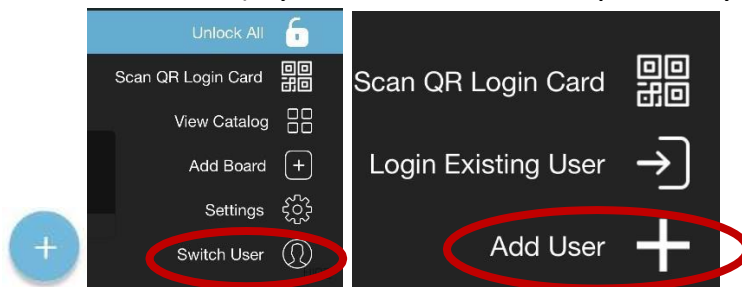
Student (Free) Can be put on any district iPad

2. If you don't have a student user set up yet. Set one up from the library dashboard. Add a User/ Student > Select the **+ icon** (lower right) > **Switch User** > **Add User** (if you have a user set up already go to step 4)



3. Add Student/User information – First **Name** is all that is needed (you could add an icon for the image if that would be helpful) > Select **Add User**

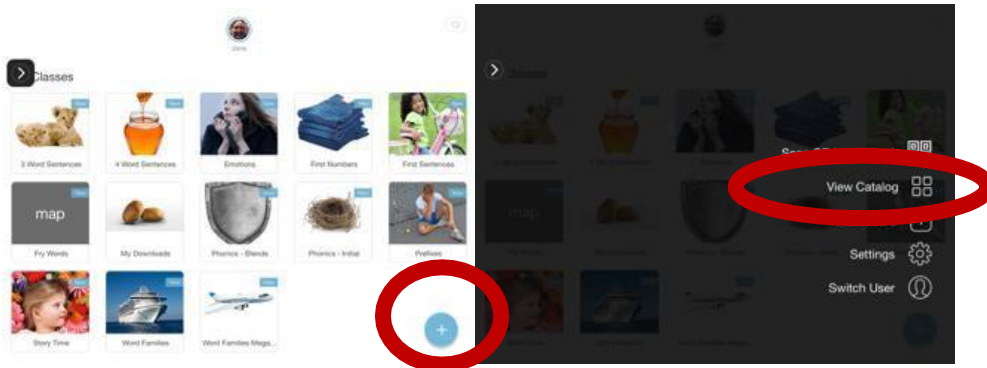
Enable cloud backup

If enabled, all user boards, stats, and settings will automatically be backed up and synchronized across

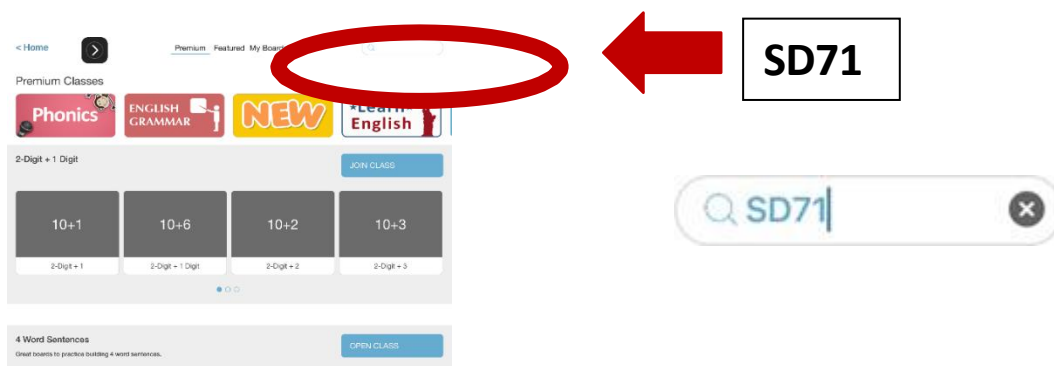
*For Staff/ User need an email and password (school district email / password - could be SD71Bitsboard). If you are authoring/ creating boards, you need a full staff/ user login.

Search Catalog for Premade Boards

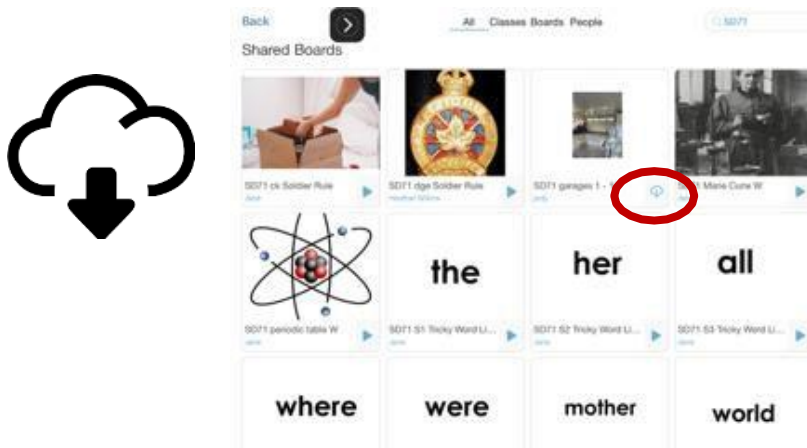
4. From the library dashboard > Select **+** icon > Select **View Catalog**



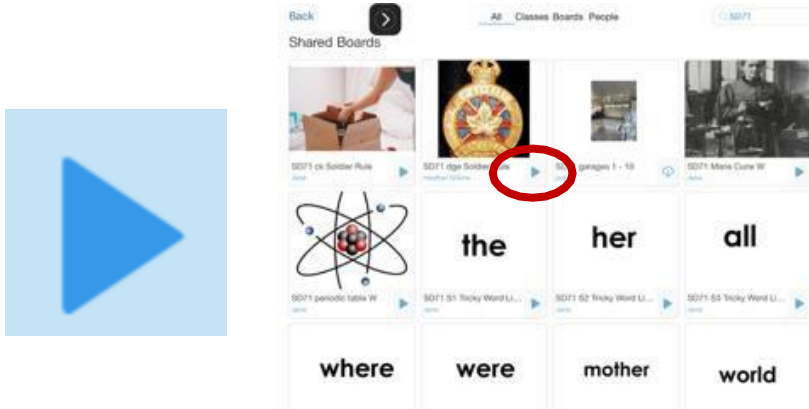
5. Search **SD71** (name of board if you know it) > **Search** in top right **search box**



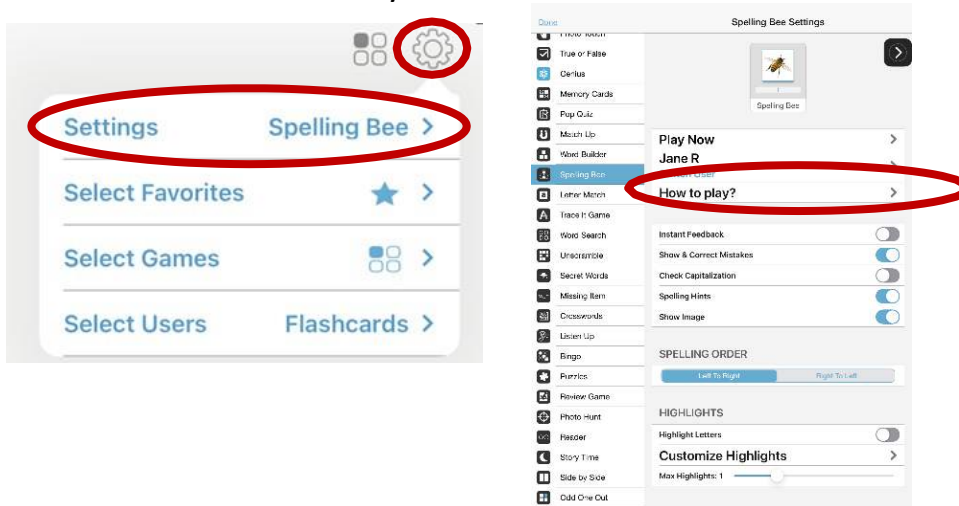
6. Locate the SD71 UFLI Board or Class (you will need to request permission).
Select the **Download Icon** to add it to your library dashboard and use the activities on that theme/ content.



- Tap the **Play arrow** to use the board OR go **Back** to the main library dashboard and select your downloaded board to use activities.



- Customize games by selecting the **Settings icon** (top right corner) and select **Settings NAME of GAME** > Customize your settings or select **How to Play?** to learn how to use activity.



**** Make library dashboard less cluttered, turn off the **Featured Boards** and **Featured Classes**. **Settings > Account (Name)**. Only have boards/ classes for the week/ unit in their library dashboard user area.**
