People can help me here.

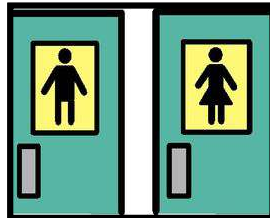


Office

At Kindergarten we . . .

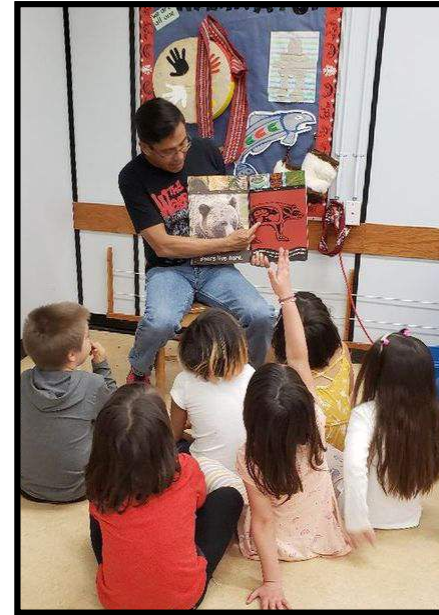

at the carpet

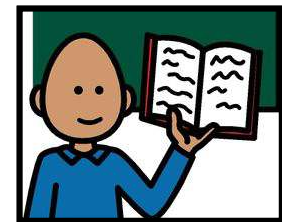


Carpet Time

bears).

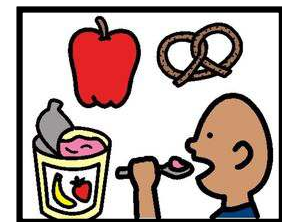


Story Time

and lunch every day.



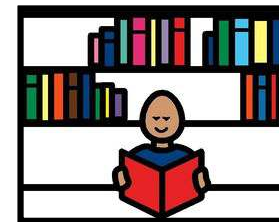
Snack

Sometimes we go to the gym, multi purpose room



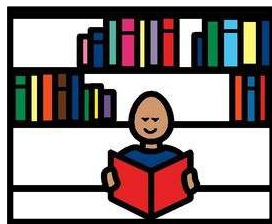
Multi Purpose Room

or the learning commons.



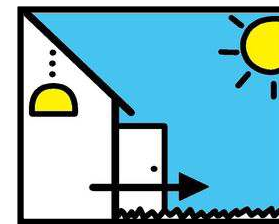
Learning Commons

learn outside.

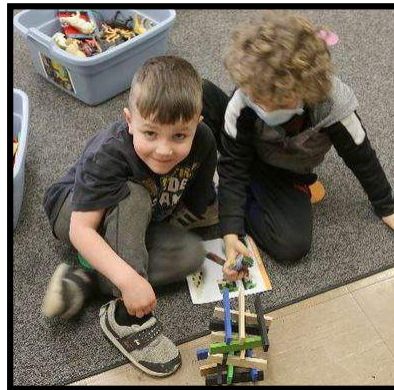

for home!



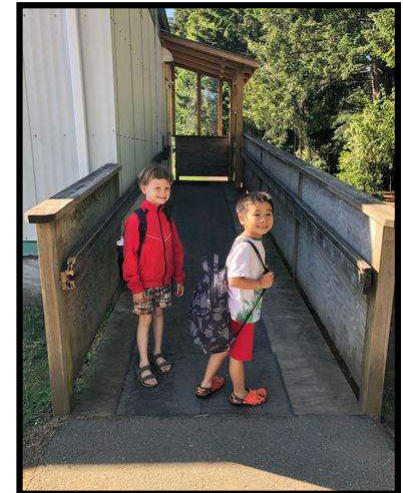
Some kids go home with an adult.



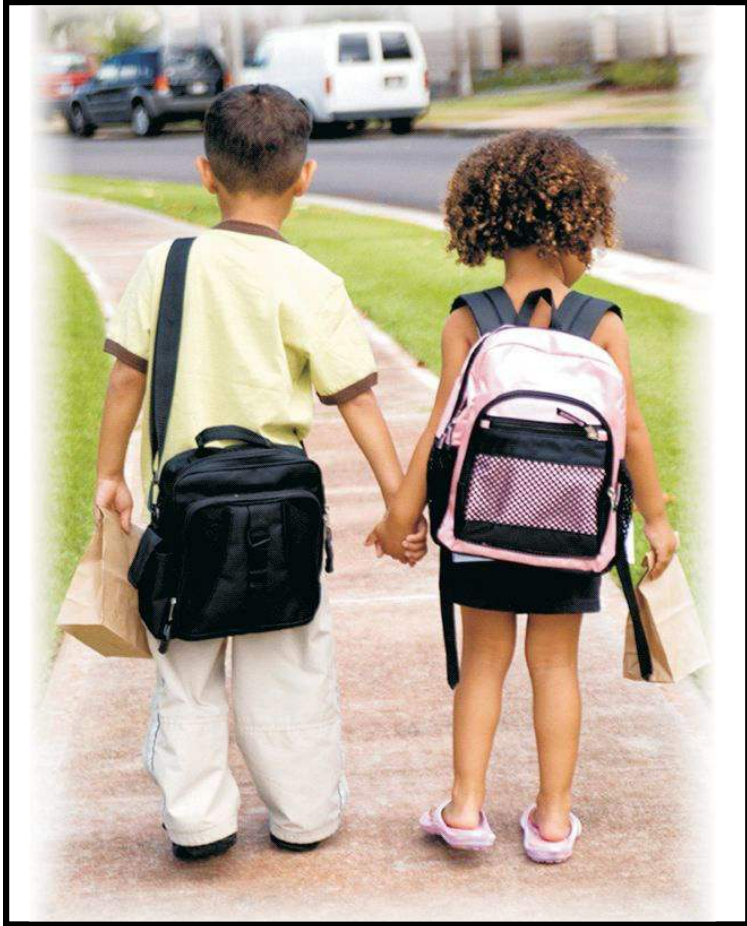
Some kids go home on the bus.
