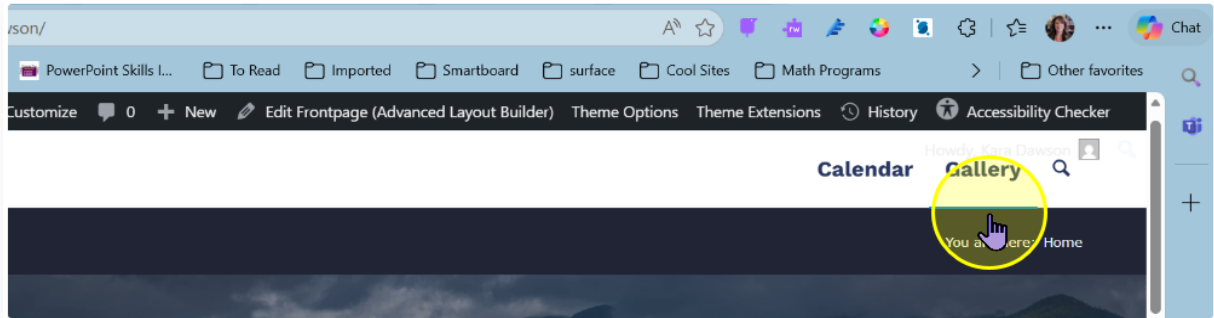


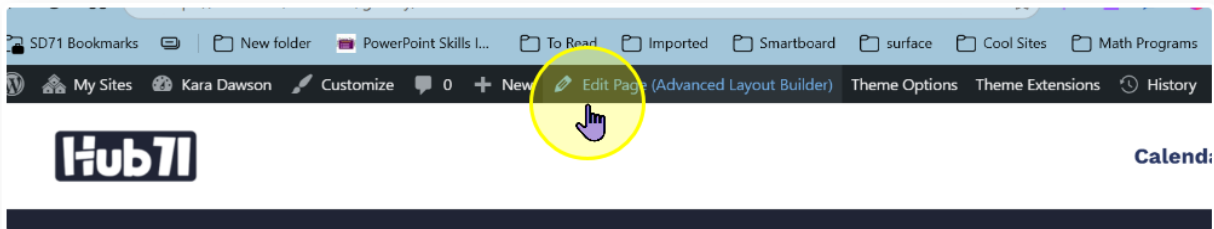
Working with Your Image Gallery

Use your image gallery to share events in your class. If you are going to post pictures and would like to keep your gallery more private you can make the page password protected and share the password with your families (instructions for this are in the Advanced section).

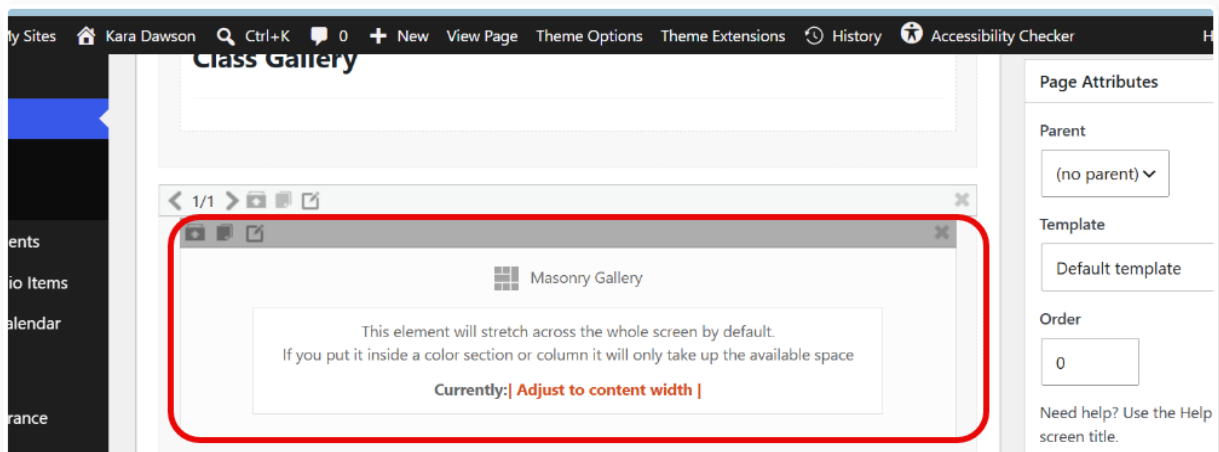
- 1 After you have logged in to Edit your website, click on the **Gallery** link.



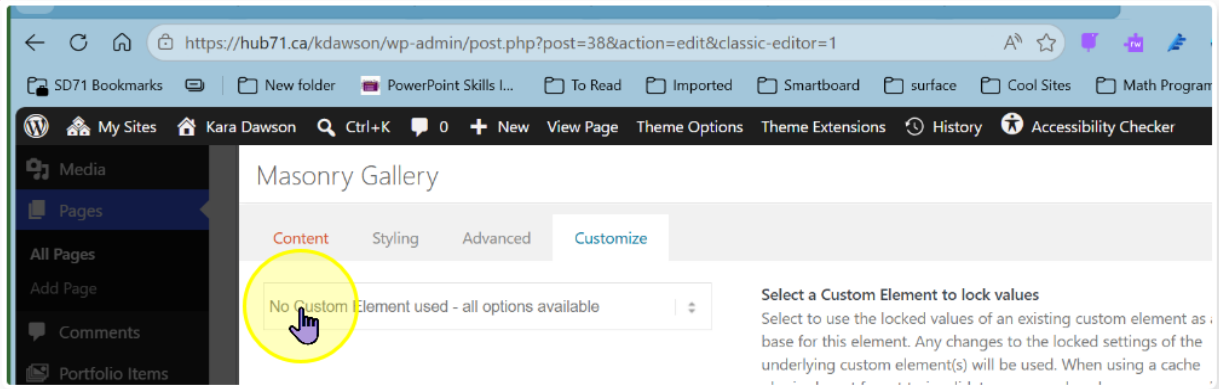
- 2 Click on **Edit**



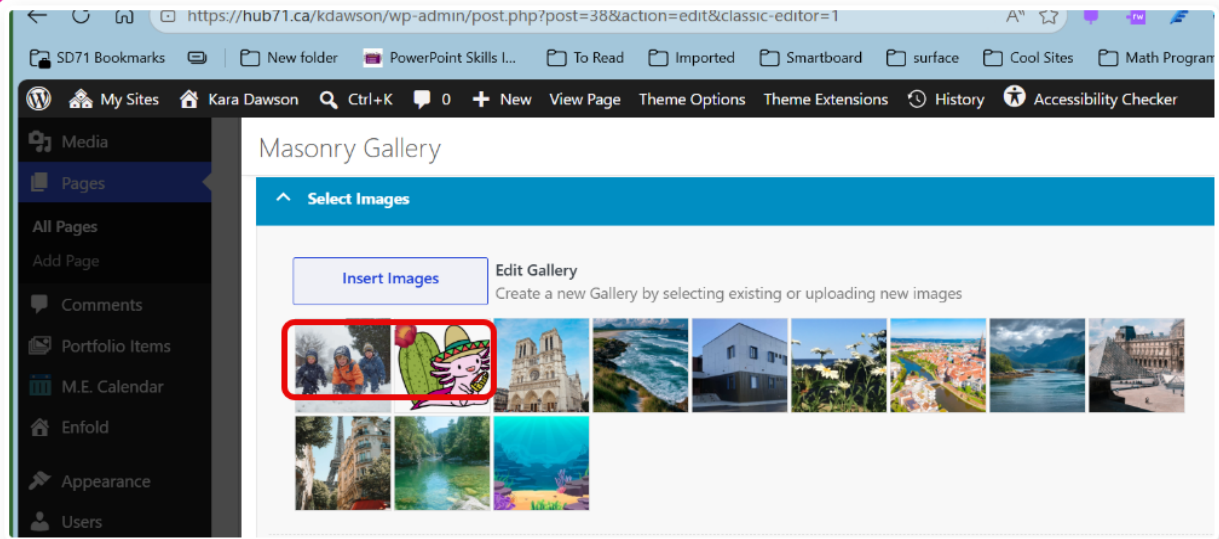
- 3 Scroll down to find the **Masonry Gallery**. Click on it to open it up.



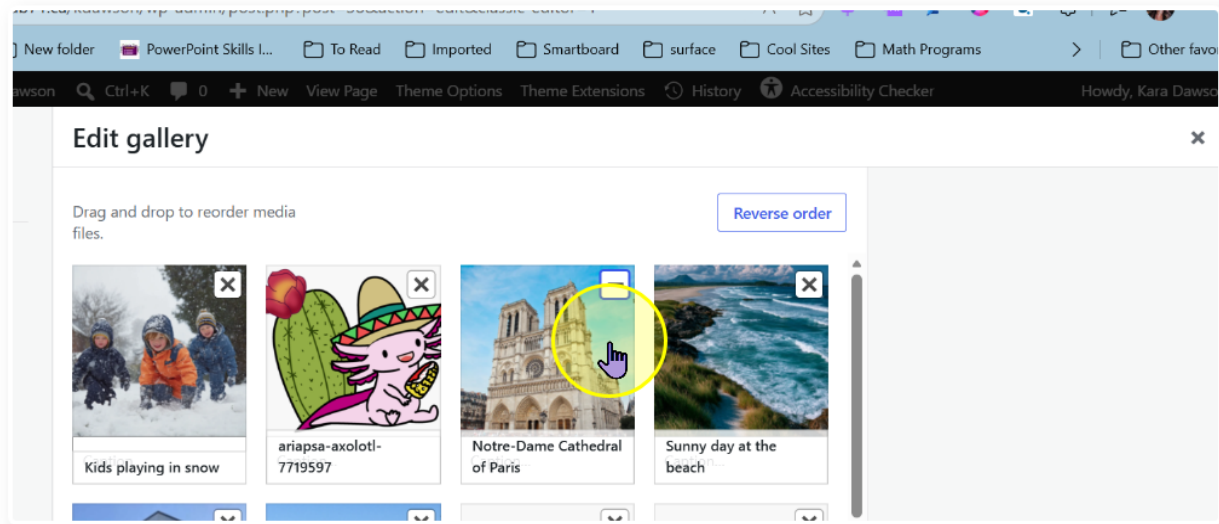
4 If you don't see the pictures, click on the **Content** tab.



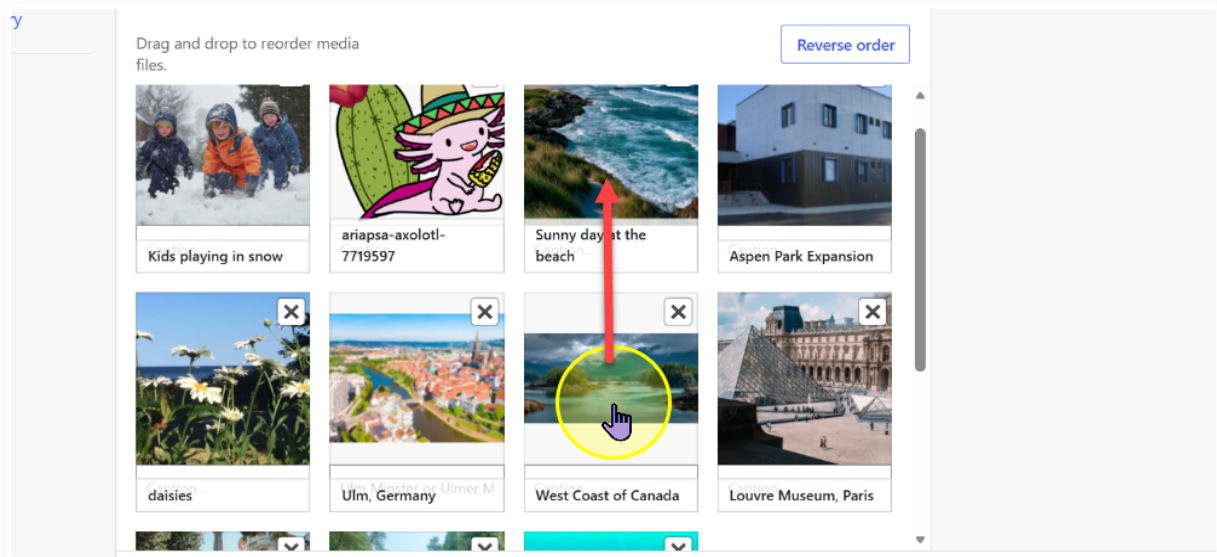
5 Click on **Insert Images** to add, delete pictures, and move them.



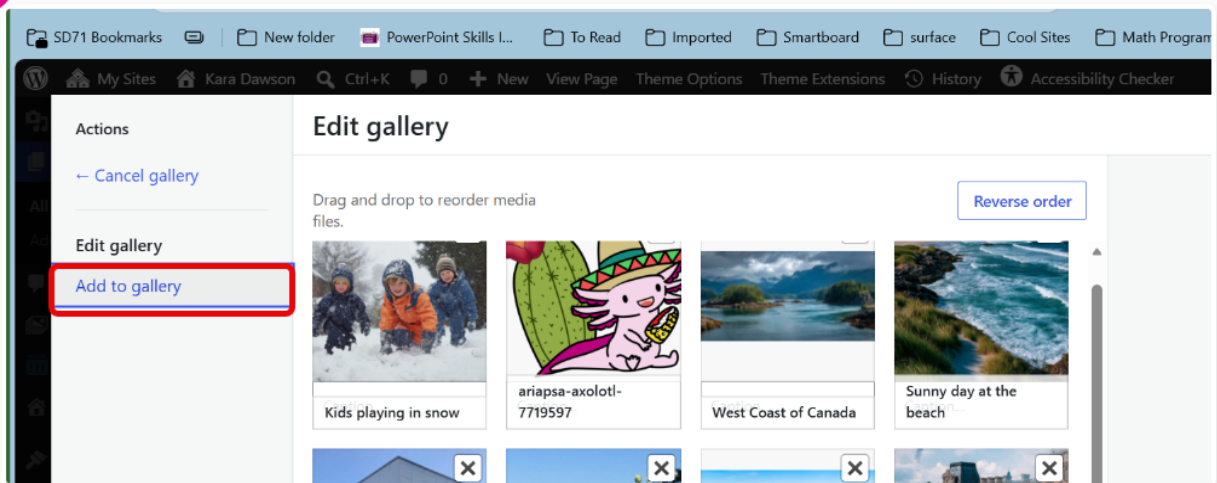
6 To Delete pictures click on the **X** in the top right corner.



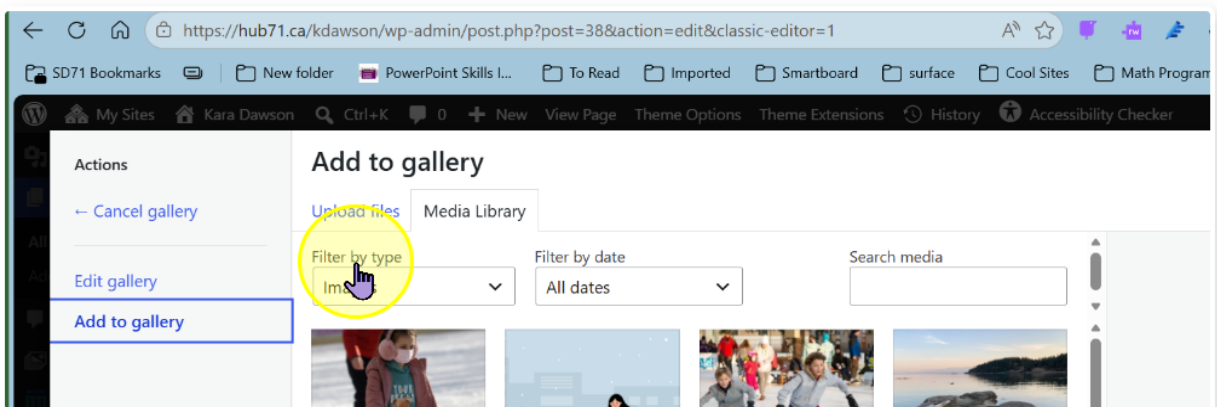
7 Drag and drop pictures to move them around.



8 Click **Add to Gallery** to add more pictures.



9 Click on **Upload files** and find the pictures that you would like to add or drag and drop them onto this screen.

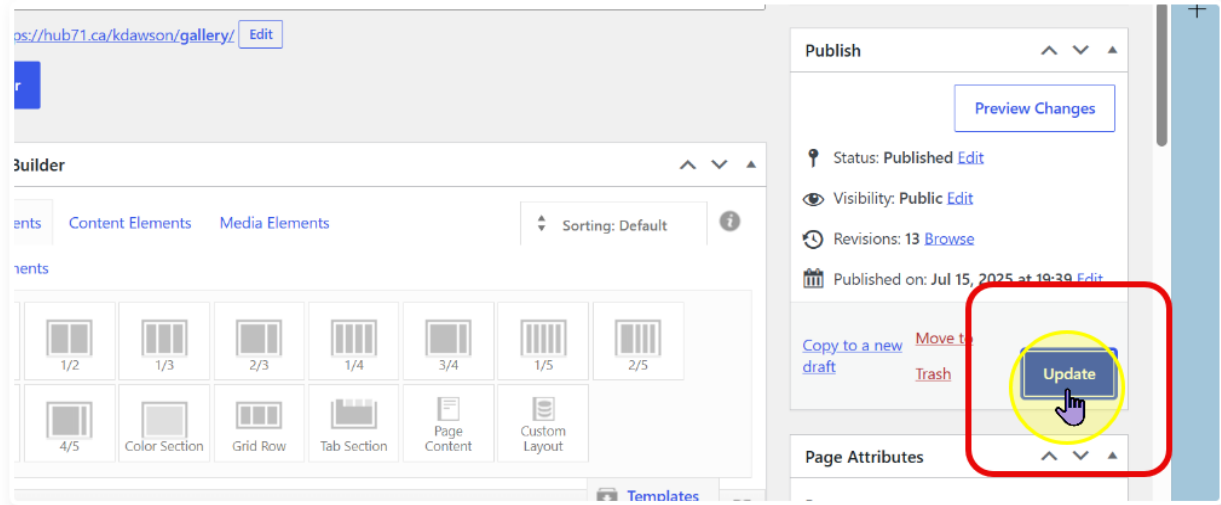
Create a new Gallery by selecting existing or uploading new images
