

# Design Activity - Pewter Casting

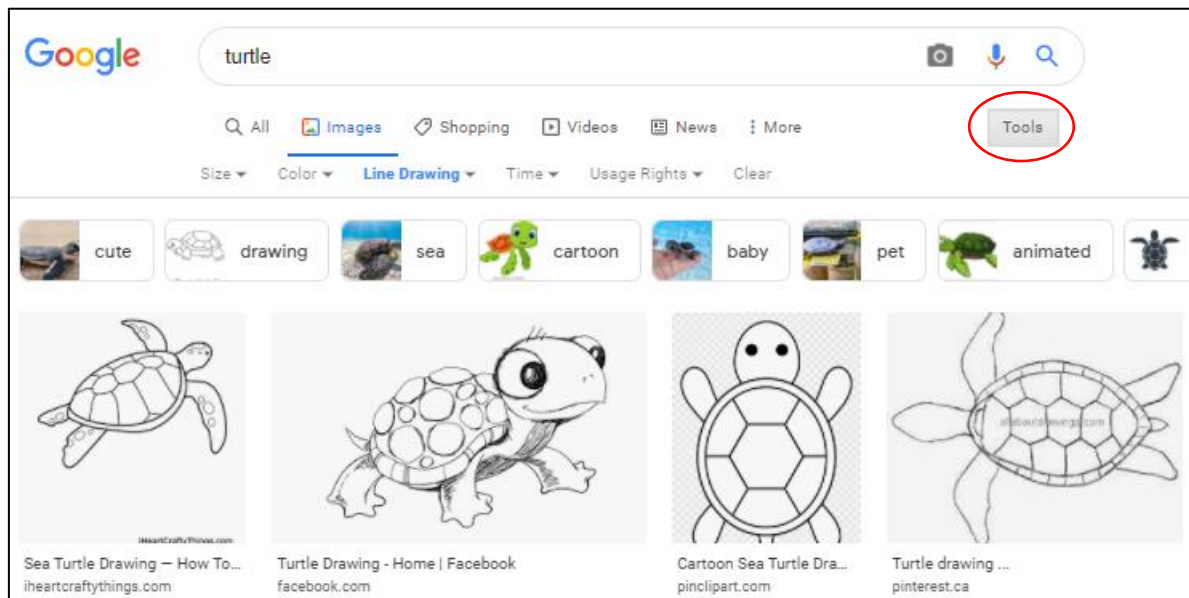
## Pendant/Charm/Fob

### Planning

The careful planning of projects is not only required before they are undertaken, but is simply just a smart way to go about things.

### Planning

**Inspiration** for design can come from many places. If you find you are struggling to come up with good practical ideas, try searching the internet. Google images is a great place to look. As simple designs are best to start with, try setting the image search to 'clip art' (under tools > type) to reduce the complexity of the image results, also try 'line drawing'.



### Design Considerations


- Level of skill/experience – keep it simple, at least until you’ve made one!
- Will your design translate well into a 3D, negative, mold?
- Will you need to have a hole to hang it from? Where will this go?

## Task

In this activity you will be asked to generate 3 quality designs that you would like to cast in pewter. The grid blocks below measure 1.5" x 1.5" and are divided into  $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. These are to be used for size reference when completing your designs.


**Complete a minimum of two designs. Have these approved by your teacher before proceeding...**

Design #2



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
